3) Evaluate $2a + 2b + 3c + 4d - 5e - 6f$ when $a = 8; b = 15; c = -3; d = 2; e = -6; f = -1$

4) When $x = 3$ and $y = 5$, by how much does the value of $3x^2 - 2y$ exceed the value of $2x^2 - 3y$?

5) Evaluate $\frac{2}{\frac{1}{7} + \frac{1}{a}}$ when $a = 3$
